Board Elections

Board Elections will be taking place soon. Ballots will be mailed to every homeowner by September 2nd. Each home is allowed one vote. Ballots must be mailed back or dropped off at the office by October 2nd. Any ballot received after October 2nd will not be counted.

The official ballot counting will take place at the October Annual General Meeting to be held on October 2nd at 7:00pm in the clubhouse.

Election results will be announced that evening and will be noted in the meeting minutes as well as in the Que Paso newsletter.

Board positions are all volunteer. Once the Board members are elected into office they decide amongst themselves what positions they will hold. This process is clearly stated in the Los Paseos Association By-Laws.

The positions held by Board members include: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and Member-at-Large. The Board is authorized to appoint one Associate Member Representative.

It is very important that everyone return their ballots. One third of ballots were returned last year and we hope to see an increase of this year. Remember, your vote counts!
