

SWIM LESSONS

We are now accepting registrations for summer swim lessons! Four sessions will be offered this summer. Each session includes eight, thirty-minute lessons over a two week period. Lessons are given Monday through Thursday between the hours of 10:00am and 12:00pm.

Children must be 4-years or older. Cost is \$65.00 per child for members and \$85.00 per child for non-members.

Here are some tips for keeping your house safe this summer.

Pool Closures

We know there is nothing fun about showing up at the pool ready to swim and finding a "Pool Closed" sign on the window.

Probably the number one cause of pool closures involves incidents of vomit or bowel movements in the pool. When this happens the entire staff jumps into action to evacuate the pool and immediately notifies our pool service. You can help reduce the number of pool closures by insuring your infant is wearing a swim diaper, available from the Gate Attendant for only \$1.00

A power outage will also cause a pool closure because our pool filters run on electricity. The health department requires that our pumps and filters are running anytime there are people in the water.

Some of the other things that cause pool closures are inclement weather like thunder storms and heavy rain. For the safety of our members, the pool will be closed if there is a possibility of an electrical storm.

We never close the pool unless there is a good reason for it. So if you show up at the pool and find that "Pool Closed" sign, don't be disappointed, be glad that we are all looking out for your health and safety. The pool will reopen as soon as possible.
